



Established in 1973, Government Serchhip College began as a shared dream of the enthusiastic citizens of Serchhip and Chhiahtlang villages, driven by the vision to provide accessible higher education to the younger generations of the region. This joint endeavor culminated in the formation of an ad hoc body on November 2nd, 1972, which embarked on a series of fundraising initiatives, including public donations, charitable contributions, and land auctions.

The college's commitment to excellence was recognized with accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) on 8th January, 2011 with a 'B' Grade status, reaffirmed in 2016 with a 'B+' Grade. In January 2022, GSC was awarded the prestigious 'A' Grade accreditation with CGPA 3.18, solidifying its position as an institution of outstanding merit and achievement.

APPLICATION CEDURE

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

BA & BSC

Candidates with Senior Secondary School Leaving Certificate of Higher Secondary (12th Grade) Certificate obtained after successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent stage of education corresponding to Level-4

BCA

Candidate with 10+2 (any stream) securing not less than 50% marks in aggregate (5% relaxation to ST/SC candidates) from the Central Board of Secondary Education or any other equivalent examination recognized by the Mizoram University

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Students can choose any of the 12 programs offered by the institution as their Major and Minor.
- 2. Multidisciplinary course (MDC) should be chosen from the following options:
- (1) History (2) Political Science (3) Economics (4) Maths (5) Botany (6) Zoology
- (7) Education (8) Geography
- 3. Subjects opted for major and minor cannot be chosen as MDC
- 4. While it is not mandatory, it is recommended that Arts students select a Science MDC and vice versa.
- 5. The Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) should be chosen from either English or Mizo.

ACCOMODATION

Government Serchhip College offers separate hostel accommodations for boys and girls, providing a comfortable and secure living environment for students.

- The boys' hostel has a capacity of 20 students, while the girls' hostel can accommodate 15 students.
- The hostels are managed by experienced wardens who ensure the students' safety and well-being.
- Common rooms and study rooms are also available in both hostels, providing students with spaces to relax, socialize, and study.
- Seats are allocated with a first-come-first-served basis and subject to seat availability.
- Interviews are conducted for the assessment of the student.
- Admission fee Rs. 2500/- Monthly fee Rs. 3000/-

Mentoring System

Mechanism

- Each year, students are assigned to teachers in groups of 10-12, with each teacher serving as their mentor for three years until they graduate.
- A proforma is created and updated each semester or year as needed to collect detailed information about each mentee.
- Mentor-mentee meetings combined with parent-teacher meetings are organized to maximize the benefit of the students.
- Faculty Ddevelopment
 Programs for mentors are also conducted, featuring expert resource persons, to enhance their skills in guiding their mentees.

- The primary goal of the Mentoring System is to reduce student dropout rates.
- Additionally, it aims to monitor students' academic progress, and attendance.
- It also endeavors to address any financial or emotional issues that could impact their studies and continuity in college.
